## WHAT THE COURSE INCLUDES

The Cert IV Community Services Qualification is the basic entry requirement for working in Community services. The WAYS Youth Training Course has been specially designed for young people, using our own Youth and Family Services and the many network partners we work with in Community Services, as practical examples students can work with.

Community services, helping others, understanding the requirements of the services and the myriad of opportunities there are in the sector, are all parts of the course.

## THE COURSE ALSO INCLUDES:

- Industry visits and relevant guest speakers covering a range of fields (youth, aged care, disability, Indigenous, CALD, and more)
- Project based work with peers and within the local community
- Career guidance and working on individual strengths
- Assistance with preparing and looking for work. This includes a resume, cover letter and assistance with interview techniques
- Work experience and links to employers, or traineeships in area of choice
- Links to further education and training options
- One on one tutoring where required
- Links to support services

## WHO ARE WAYS YOUTH TRAINING?

WAYS Youth Training (WYT) is a registered training organisation (RTO) that specialises in interactive and practical courses for young people. Completion rates are consistently over 65%

WYT is an official alternative education program approved by the Board of Studies. Students can transfer from school from 15 years of age.

WYT (RTO 90114) has delivered nationally recognised Qualifications to 15-24 year olds since 2009. It is part of WAYS Youth & Family, which also provides support services to young people in health, mental health and case management for assistance with personal issues.
