WHAT THE COURSE INCLUDES

The Hospitality Taster course is done in association Scrummies coffee bar in Oatley Learning in a real work environment.

The Course has been designed to build skills for hospitality, but it is useful as a transition to any workplace. Assistance is given to those wanting to find a job or an apprenticeship in an area of their choice, or help into further education or training options.

WHAT CAN STUDENTS ACHIEVE ON THE COURSE?

Students can achieve the following:

- Six Units of Competency (UOC) covering skills and knowledge for early entry hospitality and customer service related roles
